To become an Academic Partner, your program must:

- + Be a Master's degree-level program offered by a fully accredited college/university
- + Cover at least 70% of the information and 100% of the ethical/professional objectives required for either Part I or Part II
- + Remain current with respect to industry issues and best practices, subject to review every 3 years (with a 1-year grace period to make necessary adjustments)
- + Not partner with any other professional risk management certification
- + Proclaim the program as a GARP Academic Partner on the website and in relevant documents

Schools that choose to embed the FRM/ERP Exam into their academic program must also:

- + Register a combined minimum of 10 students or faculty members per calendar year for GARP exams
- + Make all payments for registration and related material purchase directly to GARP



Benefits

Our Academic Partnerships program works with colleges and universities, free of charge, to support their risk management programs. The goal is to help prepare students for a successful career in risk management and ultimately achieve their FRM[®] and/or ERP[®] certification.

Each Academic Partner will receive:

FRM/ERP Scholarship

We will cover the Exam Part I registration fee for one faculty member.

Student Scholarships:

We will give preferential consideration to students from Academic Partner institutions who apply for scholarships, which cover the Exam Part I registration fee.

Fellowships:

Each year, the GARP Research Fellowship Program provides up to US \$3000 in financial support for up to six research proposals from currently enrolled Master's-level students within our Partner network.

Free study materials

Partners will receive a free annual copy of relevant study guides, program manuals, and practice Exams, as well as a 20% discount on an additional set of materials for the FRM or ERP

Reduced advertising rates

We will provide a report with the aggregated performance statistics of all students and faculty who sat for the Exam.

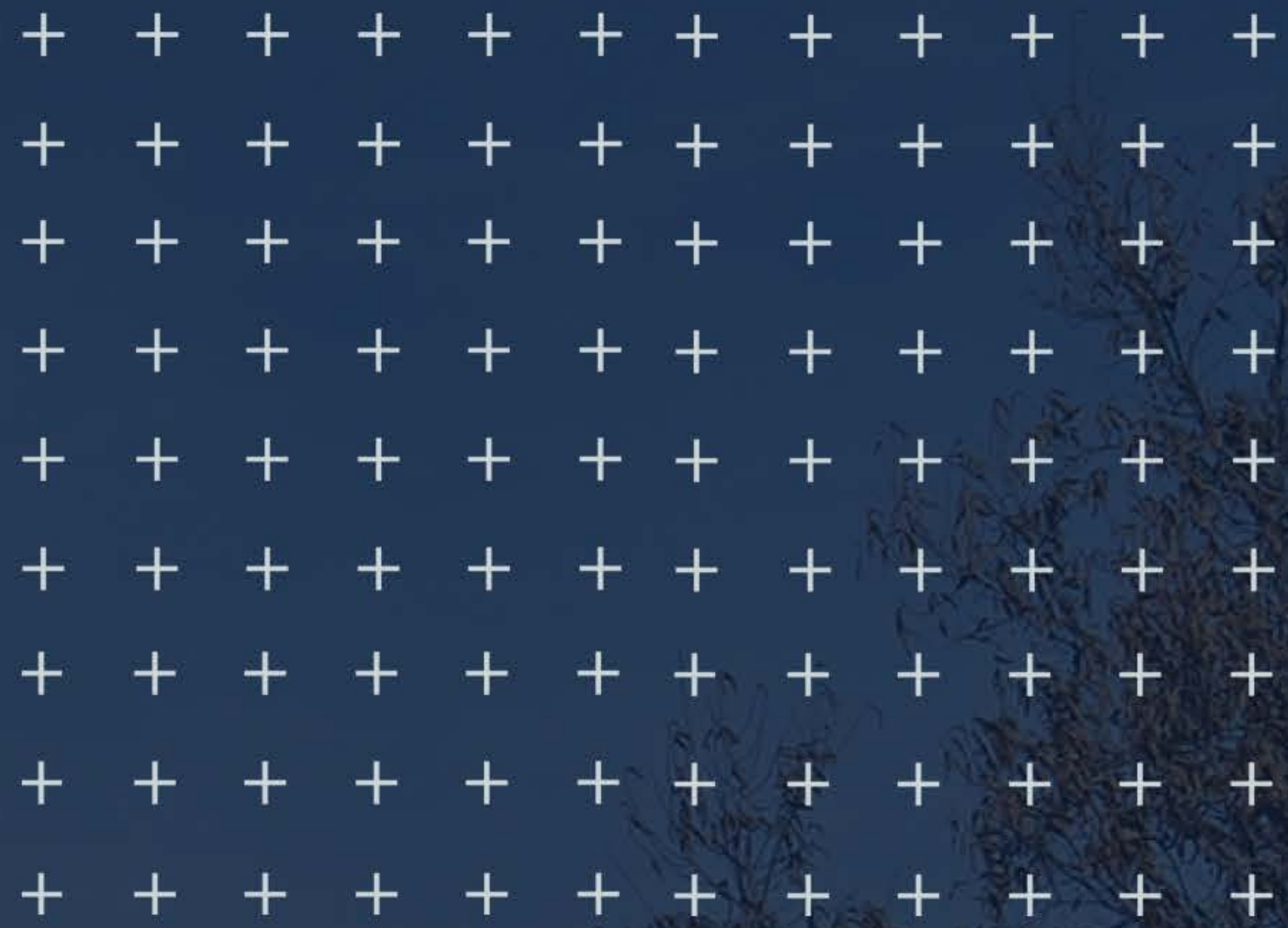
A testing center

Programs with 20 or more total candidates for our Exams qualify for an on-campus testing center.

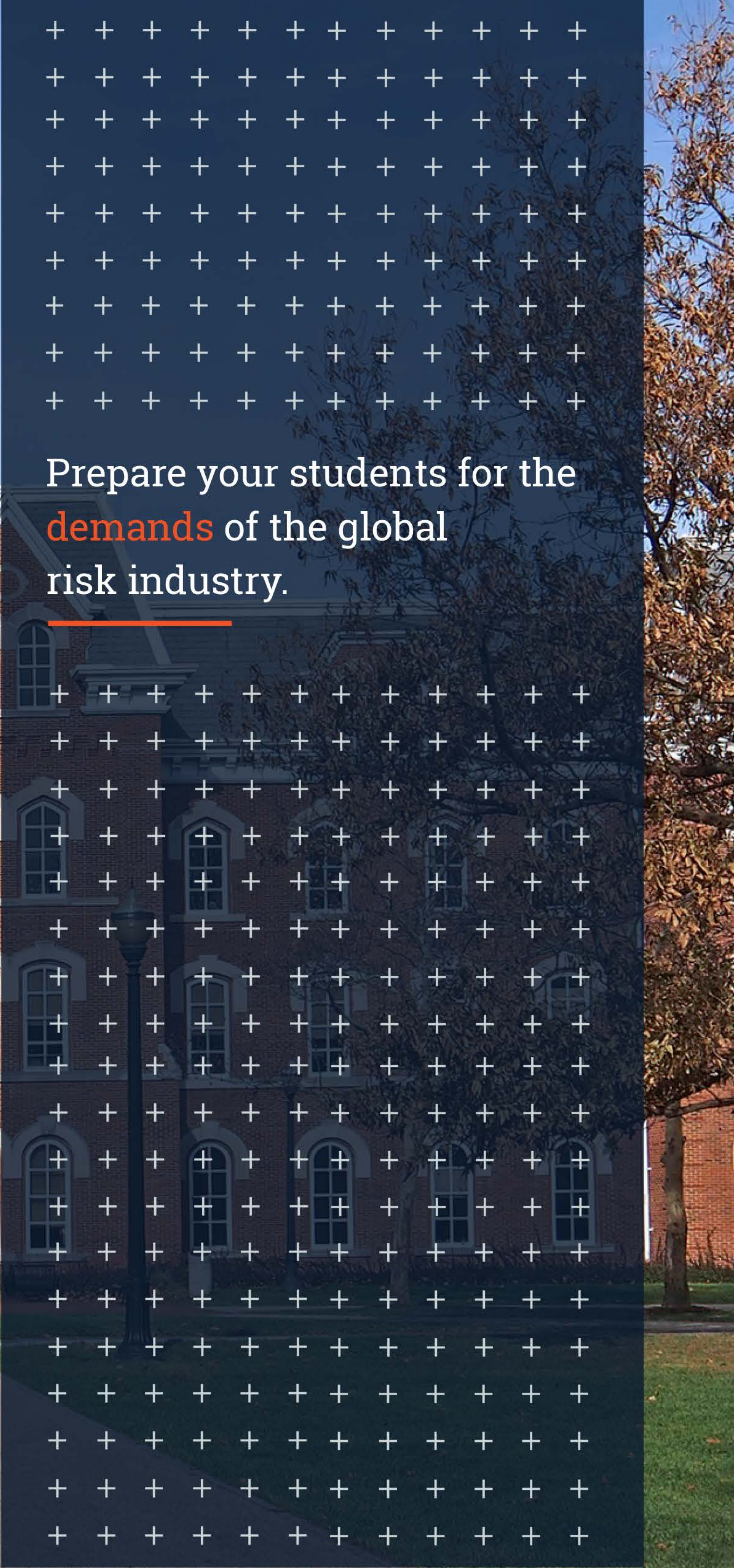
